Mutt Strut Participation Terms

- **Complete and return Reservation Form, Mutt Strut Participation Terms, and copy of Certificate of Insurance to Lake Humane Society no later than July 14, 2022.**
- Shelter/rescue group gives Lake Humane Society the right to use its name in Lake Humane Society publicity and advertising.
- Shelter/rescue group will have booth completely set up no later than 9:30am on Sunday, August 28, 2022.
- Shelter/rescue group certifies that all dogs/puppies brought to the event must have had a bordetella vaccine within the last 6 months, a DHLPP in past year, have a current rabies vaccine and certificate, are on heartworm and flea preventative medication, and have been dewormed.
- Shelter/rescue group will bring all paperwork for each animal showing proof of vaccines, etc. This paperwork will be reviewed by Lake Humane Society upon arrival at the event site.
- Shelter/rescue group will keep all animals under control on a leash or in a crate at all times.
- Shelter/rescue group will keep walkways clear and make certain none of its materials or animals encroach on an adjacent booth.
- Shelter/rescue group understands that Lake Humane Society, in its sole discretion, may refuse any request for booth space.
- Shelter/rescue group will provide supplies for its adoptable animals as it sees fit (water bowls, food, etc.)

- Shelter/rescue group will pick up any waste left by its dogs anywhere on the grounds and place it in the waste receptacles provided throughout the event area.
- Shelter/rescue group will pick up any trash left in their booth area and place it in the waste receptacles provided throughout the event area.

I/We understand that if my/our organization intends on bringing adoptable dogs, I/we must provide a copy of Certificate of Insurance PRIOR to the event (no later than July 14, 2021) which shows my/our organization carries General Liability coverage. I/We have also read and agreed to the Mutt Strut Participation Terms.
